Committee origin/authorization: *In re Arkansas Bar Association -- Petition for Adoption of Arkansas Professional Practicum; Administrative Order Number 17, 358 Ark. App'x 496* (2004). As therein designated, the Committee is composed of five members, one from each Congressional District and one from the State at large, each to serve a six-year term unless otherwise designated by the Court. Members continue to serve beyond their designated terms until such time as their successor is qualified and appointed by the Court.
