In 2010, she was elected to the Arkansas Supreme Court where she serves as the liaison to the Committee on Professional Conduct. In 2014, the Women's Law Student Association at the University of Arkansas School of Law awarded her the Gayle Pettus Pontz Award. She is a member of the Benton County Bar Association, Washington County Bar Association, Pulaski County Bar Association, Arkansas Bar Association, and Arkansas Association of Women Lawyers.
