## **eFILING IN PULASKI COUNTY JUVENILE AND CRIMINAL CASES NOW AVAILABLE**

Attorneys who participate in Pulaski County's Electronic Filing Pilot Project may now eFile to all cases in the county's circuit courts. With the September 9, 2012 activation of the criminal and juvenile case types, attorneys participating in the Electronic Filing Pilot Project may now electronically file to all cases in Pulaski County Circuit Court. Conventionally filed documents will be electronically filed by the clerk's office. The Arkansas Supreme Court authorized e-filing in July 2010. In March 2012, Pulaski County civil, domestic relations, and probate filings were made available online.

In June 2002, the AOC purchased a statewide software license from Xerox for its Contexte case management system. The license also includes a jury management system, an in-court processing module, an online traffic ticket payment module, a public access component, and the eFiling component.

Implementation of the case and jury management systems will not only improve court technology, but it will allow information-sharing with state agencies, including the Office of Driver Services and the Arkansas Crime Information Center.

The ultimate goal of the automation project is to improve public safety and to improve and promote public confidence in the judiciary by making accurate, complete, and timely court information available to the courts, justice agencies, and the public by providing a statewide court case management system to all Arkansas courts. Currently, twenty circuit courts and five district courts in the state are using or in the process of implementing Contexte. Once the eFiling pilot period ends in Pulaski County, it will be rolled out in other Contexte courts.
