**NOTICE OF SURRENDER OF ATTORNEY'S  
PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE LAW**

**IN RE: LISA GAIL BRIDGES JACKSON**  
**ARKANSAS BAR ID #87007**

Lisa Gail Bridges Jackson, an attorney residing in Maumelle, formerly practicing law in Pulaski County, Arkansas, with Arkansas Bar ID #87007 has been barred from engaging in the practice of law in this State for violation of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. On the recommendation of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, the Arkansas Supreme Court accepted the surrender of the law license of Lisa Gail Bridges Jackson on March 7, 2002.

Attorney Jackson's Petition to Surrender was based upon violation of Model Rules 3.3(a), 5.5(a), 8.4(c) and 8.4(d) of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. The Petition and attached exhibits on file with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court demonstrate that the Model Rule violations occurred as a result of Ms. Jackson's failure to pay bar dues resulting in her suspension from the practice of law. Ms. Jackson continued to practice law and to certify during the course of her employment with the Department of Justice that she did have a law license in good standing.
