**ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION**

Stark Ligon, Executive Director of the Supreme Court Office of Professional Conduct, has presented to the Committee his verified Petition for Interim Suspension, pursuant to Section 8.B(1)(c) of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (Rev.1998), (the "Procedures"), alleging Respondent Randall Wayne Dixon, Arkansas Bar ID #83052, an attorney practicing law primarily in Dardanelle, Yell County, Arkansas, presently poses a substantial threat of serious harm to the public and to his clients if he continues to practice law.

The Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct (the "Committee"), pursuant to the mandate of Section 6.B of the Procedures, finds the allegations of the petition are "serious misconduct," and involve alleged violations of the Model Rules of Professional Conduct for failure to properly represent clients, failure to appear in court, failure to communicate a settlement offer, and multiple violations of provisions relating to his attorney trust account and accounting for client funds. The Model Rules implicated are: 1.1, 1.2(a), 1.3, 1.4(a), 1.4(b), 1.15(a), 3.4(c), 8.4(a), 8.4(b), and 8.4(d).

The Committee further finds that an interim suspension of Respondent's privilege to practice law under the authority of his Arkansas law license shall be imposed pursuant to Sections 7E(3)(c), and 8B(1)(c) of the Procedures. (Rev.1998)

It is therefore ORDERED that Respondent Randall Wayne Dixon be, and he hereby is, SUSPENDED from the practice of law within this jurisdiction immediately upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
