NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF ATTORNEY'S
PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE LAW

Attorney Randall Wayne Dixon, an attorney practicing primarily in Russellville, Arkansas, Bar ID #83052, has been suspended from the practice of law within the jurisdiction of this State pursuant to Sections 7E(3)(c) and 8B(1)(c) of the Procedures of the Arkansas Supreme Court Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (Procedures). The Committee on Professional Conduct has directed that Mr. Dixon be placed on interim suspension following its review of a Verified Petition presented by Stark Ligon, Executive Director of the Office of Professional Conduct. The verified Petition demonstrated that Mr. Dixon has engaged in or is engaging in misconduct involving (1) misappropriation of funds or property and (2) a substantial threat of serious harm to the public or his clients.

Please be advised that a suspended attorney shall not be reinstated to the practice of law in this State until the Arkansas Supreme Court has received an affirmative vote by a majority of the Committee. If, and at such time as the Committee may reinstate the attorney, you will be provided notice of the reinstatement and the effective date thereof.
