**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT TO PRACTICE OF LAW**

1. Pursuant to Section 23 of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (2002), (the "Procedures"), Respondent, Reginald Shelton McCullough, submitted his Petition for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law. The Petition was considered by Panel B of the Committee on Professional Conduct at their regularly scheduled meeting on June 20, 2003.
2. Respondent was suspended from the practice of law on April 18, 2003, for a period of thirty (30) days. Respondent did not practice law nor petition for reinstatement until May 26, 2003.
3. By majority vote, Panel B has voted to reinstatement Mr. McCullough to the practice of law in Arkansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that Respondent's Petition for Reinstatement be granted and said reinstatement shall become effective upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
