BOB SAMUE CASTLEMAN, Bar No. 80024, of Pocahontas, Arkansas, has been suspended from the practice of law within the jurisdiction of this State for entering a plea of guilty to a felony on January 28, 2004, during trial in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas.
