**NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF ATTORNEY'S  
PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE LAW**

Attorney Paul E. Revels, an attorney formerly practicing in DeQueen, Sevier County, Arkansas, Bar ID #91110 has been suspended from the practice of law within the jurisdiction of this State based upon the Committee's vote, by Panel B, to immediately suspend his privilege to practice law in Arkansas. Pursuant to Section 16 of the Procedures of the Arkansas Supreme Court Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law, the Committee immediately imposed the interim suspension following the Panel's consideration of the verified Petition of the Executive Director which demonstrated that Mr. Revels had engaged in misconduct involving misappropriation of clients funds. The Committee, acting through Panel B, determined that there was a substantial threat of serious harm to the public and to the lawyer's clients, both present and future.

Please be advised that a suspended attorney shall not be reinstated to the practice of law in this State until the Arkansas Supreme Court has received an affirmative vote by a majority of the Committee. If, and at such time as the Committee may reinstate the attorney, you will be provided notice of the reinstatement and the effective date thereof.
