**ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION**


Respondent MARQUIS E. JONES, Arkansas Bar ID #74089, an attorney of Little Rock, Arkansas, was charged in September 2009 with various Rule violations on a complaint filed by Elizabeth Shaneyfelt of Manila, Arkansas.

Panel A of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, having voted in this case on July 16, 2010, to initiate disbarment proceedings against the Respondent, pursuant to the mandate of Section 16(A)(1), Procedures of the Arkansas Supreme Court Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (Rev. 2002), also finds that an interim suspension of Respondent's privilege to practice law under the authority of his Arkansas law license shall be imposed pursuant to Sections 17.E(3)(a).

IT IS ORDERED that the Arkansas law license of Respondent MARQUIS E. JONES, #74089, be, and hereby is, placed on INTERIM SUSPENSION immediately upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
