

ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT TO PRACTICE OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Section 23 of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (2011), (the "Procedures"), Attorney Charles T. Mulvey, Jr., submitted his Petition for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law. The Petition was considered by Panel B of the Committee on Professional Conduct.

2. Petitioner was placed on suspension December 28, 2010. Petitioner did not practice law nor petition for reinstatement until January 17, 2012.

3. By majority vote, Panel B has voted to reinstate Charles T. Mulvey, Jr., to the active practice of law in Arkansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that Petitioner's Petition for Reinstatement be granted and said reinstatement shall become effective upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
