**ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION**

Stark Ligon, Executive Director of the Supreme Court Office of Professional Conduct, has presented to the Committee his verified Petition for Interim Suspension, pursuant to Section 16.A(3) of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (2011) (the “Procedures”), alleging Respondent Andrea L. Davis, Arkansas Bar ID #2008056, an attorney practicing law primarily in Hot Springs, Arkansas, presently poses a substantial threat of serious harm to the public and to her clients if she continues to practice law.

The Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct (the “Committee”), pursuant to the mandate of Section 16 of the Procedures, finds the allegations of the petition are “serious misconduct,” and involve alleged violations of the Arkansas Rules of Professional Conduct.

The Committee further finds that an interim suspension of Respondent’s privilege to practice law under the authority of his Arkansas law license shall be imposed pursuant to Sections 7E(3)(c), and 8B(1)(c) of the Procedures (2011).

It is therefore ORDERED that Respondent Andrea L. Davis be, and she hereby is, SUSPENDED from the practice of law within this jurisdiction immediately upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
