ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

James H. Pilkinton, Jr., Arkansas Bar No. 73094, an attorney practicing law primarily in Hope, Hempstead County, Arkansas, is hereby placed on Interim Suspension.

A Petition for Interim Suspension was filed by Stark Ligon, Executive Director of the Office of Professional Conduct, pursuant to §16 of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law ("Procedures")(Rev. 2011), alleging that Mr. Pilkinton, Jr., presently poses a substantial threat of serious harm to the public or to the his client.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Arkansas law license of JAMES H. PILKINTON, JR., be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED immediately upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
