NOTICE OF ORDER OF DISBARMENT

IN RE: JAMES GUY TUCKER, JR. A/K/A Jim Guy Tucker

Attorney James Guy Tucker, Jr., Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas, with Arkansas Bar ID #68067, has been barred from engaging in the practice of law in this State for violation of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. On November 8, 2001, the Arkansas Supreme Court entered a Per Curiam Order granting a Petition to Disbar James Guy Tucker, Jr. filed by the Committee on Professional Conduct.

The Committee's Petition for an Order of Disbarment was based upon violation of Model Rules 8.4(b), 8.4(c) and 8.4(d) of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. The Petition and attached exhibits on file with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court, reflect that on September 28, 2001 an Agreed Order was entered in the Pulaski County Circuit Court whereby Mr. Tucker agreed to a Consent Order of Disbarment. The Disbarment was based upon Mr. Tucker's conviction in Case No. LR-CR95-173. The conviction was based upon violation of 18 U.S.C. Section 371, Conspiracy to Defraud the United States and a violation of 18 U.S.C. Section 1341, Mail Fraud, both felonies.
