**PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE LAW**

**IN RE: MARION DOUGLAS WOOD**

Marion Douglas Wood, an attorney residing and formerly practicing law in Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas, with Arkansas Bar ID #74155 has been barred from engaging in the practice of law in this State for violation of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. On the recommendation of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, the Arkansas Supreme Court accepted the surrender of the law license of Marion Douglas Wood on September 20, 2001.

Attorney Wood's Petition to Surrender was based upon violation of Model Rule 8.4(b) of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. The Petition and attached exhibits on file with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court demonstrate that Mr. Wood was convicted of ten counts of Conspiracy and Mail Fraud by jury in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana. Mr. Wood was found to have violated the following federal statutes, 18 U.S.C. Sections 371, 1341, 1343, 1346, 1956 and 1957.
