NOTICE OF SURRENDER OF ATTORNEY'S  
PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE LAW

IN RE: CARL FREDERICK MOYER

ARKANSAS BAR ID #90067

Carl Frederick Moyer, an attorney formerly residing in Green Forest and Monticello, and formerly practicing law in Carroll County and Drew County, Arkansas, with Arkansas Bar ID #90067 has been barred from engaging in the practice of law in this State for violation of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. On the recommendation of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, the Arkansas Supreme Court accepted the surrender of the law license of Carl Frederick Moyer, on November 1, 2001.

Attorney Moyer's Petition to Surrender was based upon violation of Model Rules 1.1, 1.2(a), 1.3, 1.4(a), 1.16, 3.2, 3.3(a)(1), 3.4(d), 8.4(c) and 8.4(d) of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. The Petition and attached exhibits on file with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court demonstrate that the Honorable Alan Epley filed a complaint on behalf of Mr. Moyer's client Timothy Campbell. Mr. Moyer failed to file an answer to a counterclaim on behalf of Mr. Campbell and also failed to respond to discovery which caused his client to have a \$13,000 judgment entered against him. In addition, Mr. Moyer's clients, Michael and Tammy Warner, filed a complaint against Mr. Moyer for failure to appear for trial which caused their case to be dismissed. In addition, the Arkansas Supreme Court issued a Per Curiam in the case of *Joe Boblett v. State of Arkansas* wherein it is found that Mr. Moyer failed to perfect the criminal appeal of Mr. Boblett in 1998.
