**PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE LAW**

Attorney Heather Patrice Hogrobrooks, an attorney formerly practicing law primarily in Forrest City, and West Memphis, Arkansas, Bar ID #92029 has been suspended from the practice of law within the jurisdiction of this State for violation of Model Rules 1.1, 1.2(a), 1.3, and 3.4(c) of the Arkansas Model Rules of Professional Conduct. The Findings and Order of Discipline of the Committee reflect that Ms. Hogrobrooks was found to have violated these Model Rules as the result of a complaint filed by Kenneth Hunt. The Committee on Professional Conduct suspended Heather P. Hogrobrooks' Arkansas Attorney's License for a period of one (1) year effective October 10, 2001.

Please be advised that a suspended attorney shall not be reinstated to the practice of law in this State until the Arkansas Supreme Court has received an affirmative vote by a majority of the Committee. If, and at such time as the Committee may reinstate the attorney, you will be provided notice of the reinstatement and the effective date thereof.
