**NOTICE OF SURRENDER OF ATTORNEY'S
PRIVILEGE TO PRACTICE LAW**

Kenneth W. Haynes, an attorney residing in West Helena, Arkansas, with Arkansas Bar ID #95178 has been barred from engaging in the practice of law in this State for violation of the Model Rules of Professional Conduct. On the recommendation of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, the Arkansas Supreme Court accepted the surrender of the law license of Kenneth W. Haynes on December 11, 2003.

Mr. Haynes' Petition to Surrender was based upon his plea of guilty to the criminal offense of conspiracy to possess a controlled substance. Mr. Haynes' plea was made before the Circuit Court of Phillips County on September 16, 2003, in the case of *State of Arkansas v. Kenneth W. Haynes*, No. CR-2002-182.
