**ARKANSAS SUPREME COURT TO CONDUCT  
ORAL ARGUMENTS IN BLYTHEVILLE THURSDAY**

The Arkansas Supreme Court will conduct oral arguments in Blytheville April 08, 2010 at Arkansas Northeastern College in the Adams/Vines Recital Hall, located at 2501 South Division (US Hwy 61). The argument will begin at 9 a.m. and is open to the public.

The Court will go into informal session for a few minutes right at 9 a.m. to allow for photographs. Case No. CR09-1016, *Paul Anthony Norris v. State of Arkansas*, is a criminal appeal from Saline County Circuit Court. Following arguments, the justices will each go to different schools and classes to visit with students.

The Supreme Court is committed to providing more Arkansas citizens an opportunity to see how the state's Court and the appellate process work. Since 2002, oral arguments have been held in Fayetteville, Fort Smith, Jonesboro, Monticello, Hope, Harrison, Bentonville, Helena and Hot Springs.

Amendment 80 to the Arkansas Constitution, adopted by vote of the people in 2000, provides that the Supreme Court may meet at such times and places as designated by the Court.
