**SUPREME COURT TO CONDUCT ORAL ARGUMENT
IN EL DORADO ON OCTOBER 11, 2012**

The Arkansas Supreme Court will conduct oral arguments in El Dorado, at the El Dorado Conference Center-Murphy Hall II, on Thursday, October 11, 2012. The argument will begin at 9:00 a.m. (the Court will go into informal session for a few minutes right at 9:00 to allow for photographs). The public is welcome to attend. The case that will be argued is *HPD, LLC. v. Tetra Technologies, Inc., Case No. 11-1299*. Following the oral argument, the justices will visit schools in the El Dorado area.

This will be the 15th occasion in the last ten years that the Supreme Court has held court outside of Little Rock. The Supreme Court is committed to providing more Arkansas citizens an opportunity to see how the state's highest court and the appellate process work. Since 2002, the Supreme Court has held oral arguments in Fayetteville (twice), Fort Smith, Jonesboro (twice), Monticello, Hope, Harrison, Bentonville, Helena, Hot Springs, Blytheville, Texarkana, and Pine Bluff. Amendment 80 to the Arkansas Constitution, adopted by vote of the people in 2000, provides that the Supreme Court may meet at such times and places as designated by the Court
