## PER CURIAM

Pursuant to Administrative Order Number 14, administrative plans have been submitted by the various judicial circuits, and the court has reviewed them. All of the administrative plans are approved. These plans shall be effective January 1, 2008, unless otherwise noted.

By *per curiam* order we have amended Administrative Order Number 18 to address jurisdiction of pilot state district court judgeships. See *In Re Administrative Order Number 18 -- Adoption of New Section 6 -- Jurisdiction of Pilot State District Court Judgeships* (September 27, 2007). In that *per curiam* order, we point out that in order to implement a provision of Administrative Order Number 18 ["Other Matters" (6)(b)(4)], guidelines and procedures must be set out in a circuit's administrative plan. Those circuits having pilot state district court judgeships<sup>1</sup> have already submitted their administrative plans for 2008. If any of these circuits want to take advantage of this "Other Matters" provision, we encourage them to formulate appropriate guidelines and submit an amended administrative plan to the supreme court. would therefore be prudent for the circuits with pilot state district court judgeships to review revised Administrative Order Number 18 and determine whether any other amendments to their administrative plans are warranted.
