ARKANSAS SUPREME COURT LIBRARY

History

The Arkansas Supreme Court Library, founded by the Supreme Court Library Act of 1851, serves the appellate courts of Arkansas. It is the oldest library in Arkansas that is still operating.

Services

The library serves the Arkansas Supreme Court, the Arkansas Court of Appeals, Administrative Office of the Courts, Office of Professional Conduct, Office of Professional Programs, and staff. The library also provides information services to other state agencies. The library serves attorneys, law school students, and self-represented litigants (SRLs). The library is open to the public.

Resources

Resources offered by the library include a retrospective collection of primary and secondary legal materials. The library offers access to legal online databases, such as WESTLAW, Lexis, HeinOnline, and The Making of Modern Law.

Depository Collections

The library is designated a federal depository library and an Arkansas state depository, providing access to U.S. government documents and Arkansas government documents.

Equipment & Facilities

The library offers, for public use, three computers, a photocopy machine, fax machine, microform reader/printer, and electric typewriter. A charge is made for photocopies, printing on the laser printer, and sending faxes.

THEMIS Online Catalog

The Arkansas Supreme Court Library and UALR Law School Library share the THEMIS online catalog (<http://themis.law.ualr.edu/>), which provides bibliographic access to the libraries' collections. The libraries have reciprocal agreements for interlibrary loan and photocopying.

Arkansas Legal Index (ARLI)

The Arkansas Legal Index, accessible via THEMIS, indexes articles in *Arkansas Law Notes*, *Arkansas Law Review*, *Arkansas Lawyer*, and *UALR Law Review*, as well as other selected Arkansas legal materials.
