COURT ORDERED MEDIATIONS IN ARKANSAS

2013 STATISTICS FACT SHEET

The following information is based on 378 statistical reporting forms submitted by certified mediators for the period September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013. This report covers only cases ordered to mediation by the Arkansas Circuit Courts, and does not include statistics on cases mediated at the district court or appellate court level. Also not included are cases in which the parties voluntarily or privately submitted their case to mediation. Included in this report is a copy of the Statistical Reporting Form used to compile this data (see last page).

RESULTS OF COURT ORDERED MEDIATION SESSIONS:

What types of cases were ordered to mediation? (See Chart 1)

Civil - 82 cases (21%)
Domestic Relations – 278 cases (74%)
Juvenile – 7 cases (2%)
Probate – 11 cases (3%)

Did the mediation take place? (See Chart 2)

No, mediation never began. – 5 cases (1%)
Yes, but mediation was halted. – 121 cases (32%)
Yes, mediation was completed with a full agreement. – 197 cases (52%)
Yes, mediation was completed with a partial agreement. – 55 cases (15%)

Did the judge send all issues of the case for mediation or limited issues? (See Chart 3)

321 cases included **all issues** (94%)
20 cases were **limited issues** (6%)

How many mediation sessions were conducted? (See Chart 4)

One session – 356 cases (96%)
Two sessions – 12 cases (3%)
Three sessions – 3 cases (1%)

How many TOTAL hours were spent in mediation? (See Chart 5)

4 hours or less – 204 cases (56%)
4.25 - 8 hours – 148 cases (40%)
8.25 - 12 hours – 11 cases (3%)
Over 12 hours – 2 cases (1%)



Did the mediation take place?



Did the Judge send all issues of the case for mediation or limited issues?



How many sessions were conducted?



How many hours were spent in mediation?




Number of Mediation Cases Ordered Per Judicial Circuit Court September 1, 2012 - August 31, 2013




Chart 6. Reports received from mediators indicate twenty-four of twenty-eight circuit courts have ordered cases to mediation.
