


**IN THE SUPREME COURT OF ARKANSAS**  
**AMENDMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN**  
**FOR THE 16TH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**


The 16th Judicial Circuit amends its Administrative Plan as follows:


Pursuant to the authority of Act 1137 of the 2011 General Assembly and Section (6)(b)(5)(B) of Administrative Order Number 18, the state district judges for the 14th Judicial District of Independence County and the 13th Judicial District of Cleburne County are hereby authorized under this Administrative Plan to preside over a drug court program, probation revocation proceeding or parole revocation proceeding in all five (5) counties of the 16th Judicial Circuit. This authority shall be coordinated by the Circuit Judge who has been assigned the jurisdiction of the Drug Court and the Criminal Division in each of the five (5) counties of the 16th Judicial Circuit.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned being the Administrative Judge of the 16th Judicial Circuit and the state district court judges for the 14th Judicial District of Independence County and the 13th Judicial District of Cleburne County agree to the above Amendment and respectfully petition the Supreme Court of Arkansas to approve the same for use in the 16th Judicial Circuit.
