100% of all adult Drug Court cases


DRUG COURT PLAN

The Van Buren and Searcy County Adult Drug Court program will begin in 2016 and will hold sessions in and for both counties. The program will utilize the re- and/or post adjudication process and is open to defendants with a felony charge, non-violent offenders. The program is conducted in conformance with the Arkansas Drug Court Statute (A.C.A. 16-98-301 et seq.) and will comply with applicable laws involving the assessment of fines, court costs, and probation fees. The program receives staff funding from the Public Defenders Commission, Department of Arkansas Community Corrections, the State of Arkansas and the collection of fees.

The members of the Drug Court Program team will include Circuit Judge, Prosecuting Attorney, Public Defender or Private Defense Counsel, Treatment Provider, Probation Officers, ACC Administrative Staff and Coordinator. All these have been consulted for purposes of scheduling to ensure that necessary resources are available and to avoid conflicts with other court programs and responsibilities in which the team members may be required to participate.




